Have a lovely half term with your families. We return to school on 7th June 2021.

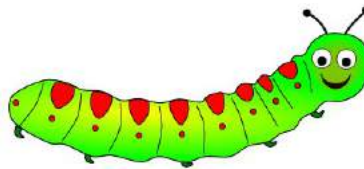
