**PAYMENT**

First of all, please pay for the event on sQuid, by Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> September.  
**The cost is £10 per child.**

**PLAN**

**On the morning of September 30<sup>th</sup>, please send your child into school with all the things they will need for the sleepover;** they will be remaining here when the rest of the pupils go home at 3:20pm.

We will start with some fun on the field and then have dinner. The school will order margherita pizzas for everyone and we'll also cook some hotdogs.

(If your child requires an alternative dinner, please make a note of this in the 'alternative dinner and allergies' box on sQuid).

We will carry on with some games outside after dinner, and then head inside for a film and popcorn. We will make up beds and set up each room with mats on the floor. **Boys and girls will be in separate rooms.**

**WHAT TO PACK**

- a sleeping bag and a pillow, or a duvet and a pillow, and possibly a camping mat.
- a torch or a head torch;
- toothbrush and toothpaste;
- night clothes;
- a change of socks and underwear;
- clothes suitable for outdoor learning for Thursday evening and for the MAD education day on Friday.

On Friday morning, we will give the children a breakfast of toast and cereal, and then get ready for our MAD activity day.

**MEDICATION**

Please also make sure that an adult brings any medication that the children will need over night to the Year 6 entrance on Severn Drive when the children are dropped off on Thursday morning.
