4W

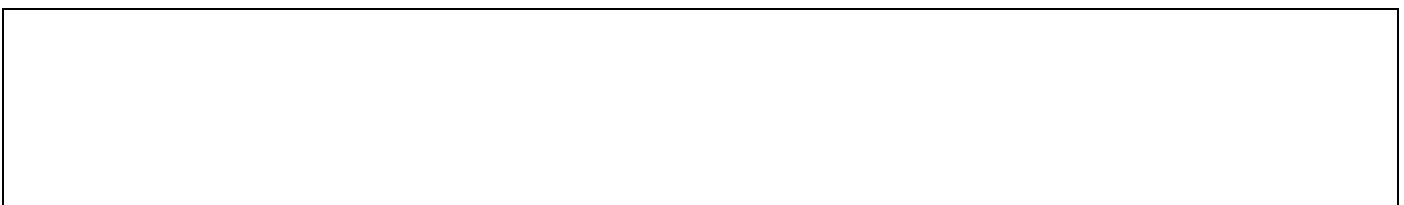
