Morning session ; CELTIC FOREST SCHOOL EXPERIENCE-

- Old joggers/trousers (no jeans)
- **Long sleeved top**
- Thick jumpers/sweaters
- Thermals would be beneficial when it gets very cold – but not a necessity
- Thick socks
- Hats and gloves (weather dependent).

A plain or tartan type blanket to wear over their forest school clothes. Plus a belt and large safety pin.
