Description of task	Next week we are going to be creating our own newspaper reports. Have a look with a grown up at a newspaper and see if you can find the main features of an article. Do all articles have the same features? For example, headings, opening paragraphs, pictures, captions. Have a go at writing a newspaper report or creating a video one (like the newsreaders on the TV or radio) about the book you have most recently read or something that you did over the weekend.		Next week in Maths we will be focussing on money. Have a look at some money this week and have a go at some of these activities: 1. Identify the coins and notes by their value and then practice working out how many of each coin equal the value of another coin; for example, $2 \times 5p = 10p$ or $2p + 2p + 1p + 5p = 10p$ 2. Practice converting pence into pounds; for example, $156p = \text{£}1.56$ 3. Play shops with someone at home. They need to buy something and you need to work out how much change they need and which coins or notes you are going to use to give it to them. For example; if a bag of oranges cost $\text{£}1.32$ and you are given $\text{£}2$ how much change does that person need? 4. Practise adding and subtracting with money. For example; $\text{£}1.43 + \text{£}3.67 =$
