Use of Goggles during swimming lessons

Some pupils may wish to wear swimming goggles to reduce the discomfort that sometimes occurs whilst swimming, although this is not usually necessary. We would encourage parents to only authorise the use of goggles where it is absolutely necessary. However, should you wish your child to wear swimming goggles the following safety information and guidance must be adhered to in order to ensure the safety of your child and others taking part in the lesson.

Safe Choice

There is a British Standard for manufacturers, always purchase a well-known brand

Safe Use

If goggles fill with water whilst in use, remove them completely to clear. Never pull goggles away from eyes as they may fly back and cause a serious eye injury. Always ensure the goggles are over the eyes whilst swimming (not on the forehead).

Goggles should NOT be used

- When diving.
- Whilst taking part in certain water skills awards.
- When requested by teacher to remove them.

Points to remind your child

- Never pull the goggles away from your own eyes.
- Remove goggles by slipping them off the head and not stretching the retaining band.
- Never interfere with goggles worn by someone else.
