



Public Sector Equality Duty.

The Public Sector Equality Duty of 2010 requires all public bodies to consider all individuals when carrying out their day to day work and to eliminate discrimination, advance equality of opportunity and foster good relationships between different people when carrying out their activities.

We do all in our power at Engayne Primary School to ensure that there is equality of opportunity for everyone in our school community and that nobody is discriminated against. The following are our three objectives:

- To develop a pastoral team of staff so an increased number of pupils can access additional support both in school eg ELSA and with outside agencies. (SIP 22/23)
- Reduce the number of incidents involving poor behaviour (including bullying / use of offensive language) at lunchtime due to the implementation of OPAL
- To work towards at least the national average for all sub groups of pupils for attendance
