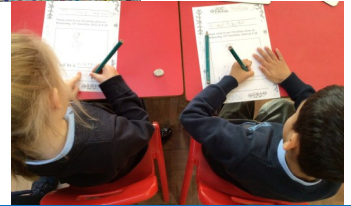




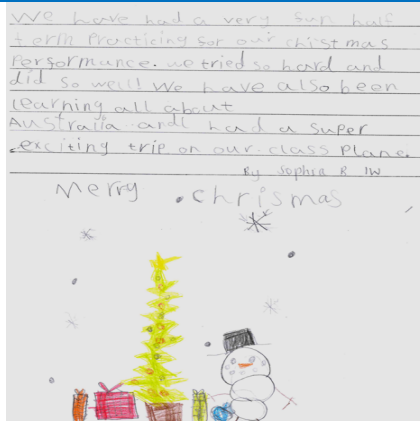
Reception
