We have created a woodland area on the school field close to the infant playground. This currently consists of around 270 trees of various species planted in a small copse around fifteen metres by ten metres. A class of Y6 pupils planted this along with volunteers from Thames Chase. It was funded by Thames Chase and partly by a tree donation scheme from The Woodland Trust. Pupils will add more trees to the site in March as part of their Forest School sessions. It will take several years to develop, but eventually we will have a sheltered space where pupils can play amongst trees and tall grass.

Groundwork contractors completed a small mound and a corresponding hollow near the KS2 playground. This is currently bare earth but it will soon be seeded with grass. It should give the pupils a little topography where they can play, roll and ride. This was part-funded by a grant from Tesco. Mr Manifold




