

## Hall Mead Taster Days for Y5

Dear Parents and Carers,

Each year, Hall Mead invites the pupils of Y5 to spend a day at their school. The purpose of this day is to give the children a taste of life in secondary school.

Each of our Y5 classes will visit Hall Mead on a different day. This year's dates are as follows:

**5W will need to take PE kit with them.**

Your child will experience a typical day in the life of a secondary school. Each class will take part in a different series of lessons, depending on which secondary teachers are scheduled to take them.

**Parents will need to drop their children off at the main reception area of Hall Mead School at 8:30am and collect them from the same place at Hall Mead School at 3.05pm, OR you will need to give permission for your child to walk home alone.** A teacher and another adult from Engayne will be there to welcome children at the secondary school and they will spend the day with them. Children will need to take paper, pen, pencil, snack, packed lunch and water.

**It is important that we know how pupils will be going home at the end of the day: will they be collected by a parent, or will they walk home by themselves. Please log onto your sQuid account and look for 'Hall Mead walking home permission'.** There, you will need to indicate whether your child has permission to walk home alone or not.
