Can you put the cubes into pairs? Do you think 7 is an even or an odd number? Why do you think that?</p> <p><u>Challenge 2</u></p> <p>Collect an odd number of cubes. How do you know you have an odd number? Add 1 more cube. Do you still have an odd number of cubes?</p> <p><u>Challenge 3</u></p> <p>Add 2 even numbers together. Is the answer odd or even?
