Dear Parents and carers,

This year, we would like all children in Years 3-6 to Share their Love of Reading.

- We are challenging the children to read at least six books during the summer holiday. If they are participating in the Havering Library Summer challenge, then these books can also be used to complete our homework challenge.
- To complete the challenge, children can read a variety of texts. This could include:

Story books	Factual books	Poetry Collection
Picture books	A book they read to someone younger	Tradition tales / fairy stories Myths and legends

- Once the children have read a book, they need complete tasks from the list below.

Reading challenge tasks. Only complete six of these	
Comic strip Choose the five most important events that happened in your book. Turn them into a comic strip.	Missing Poster Create a wanted poster for a character from your book. Include their description, what they did and what the reward will be.
New illustration Find a part of your story that does not already have an illustration. Create a picture that shows what is going on. This can be drawn, painted or computer generated.	Write a letter Imagine you are one of the characters in the story. Write a letter to a friend to explain something you have done, or to ask them for their advice about a problem.
Five truths and Five Lies Write down five true things and five lies about the story or book you have read.	New Cover Design a new front cover for your book. It needs to include a picture, title, author and illustrator.
Summary Write a summary of your book in no more than 100 words.	New Title Think of a new title for the book you have read. Explain why you think this title would suit your book.
Word Search Use up to 15 words related to characters or information given in the book. Create a wordsearch using these. Remember to give your work a title and write the words to find in a list.	Art task. Represent an event or character from your book. This could be: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Drawn or painted• Computer generated• A 3D model.

- They should return these tasks to their class teacher by **FRIDAY 13th SEPTEMBER**. There will be both classroom and school displays to showcase examples of work that the children produce.
